


**Family Medicine Minimum Criteria for the NMRP Match  
Program #: 1202500736**

The following will be included in the pre-screening criteria

- Time since graduation:
  - ◆ We will only consider students who have graduated within one year of the match (example: student graduates in May 2018 but did not match in 2018. We would only consider again for the 2019 match).
  - ◆ Students who will not be graduating in the same year as the match will be looked at on a case by case basis to consider for interview.
- Minimum OPP requirements:
  - ◆  Must be a graduate of a COM medical school or show:
    - ◆ 1. Evidence of training in osteopathic philosophy, history, terminology, and code of ethics.
    - ◆ 2. Evidence of training in anatomy and physiology related to osteopathic medicine.
    - ◆ 3. Evidence of training on indications, contraindications, and safety issues associated with the use of osteopathic manipulative treatment.
    - ◆ 4. Evidence of training in palpatory diagnosis, osteopathic structural examination, and osteopathic manipulative treatment.
    - ◆ 5. This evidence will be reviewed and approved by the residency selection committee to determine the adequacy of meeting minimum requirements.
- Suggested minimum board scores with a first time pass:
  - ◆ 430 on COMLEX I and II AND first time pass on PE component
  - ◆ USMLE Step I score of  $\geq 205$ , USMLE Step II score of  $\geq 220$
  - ◆ Any scores below the suggested minimum score or those who require multiple attempts to pass will be looked at on a case by case basis.
